NAFINE CREAM

Terbinafine hydrochloride (1% w/w)

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What Nafine is used for

It is used in the treatment of skin infections due to fungus, yeast and pityriasis versicolor. (fungal infection of the skin)

How Nafine works

Nafine destroys the fungus and molds that causes the infection.

Before you use Nafine

- When you must not use it
- allergic to terbinafine hydrochloride or other ingredients of Nafine.
- Before you start to use it

Contact with eyes is to be avoided. If irritation occurs for sensitive patients, treatment should be discontinued.

Pregnancy and breastfeeding
Terbinafine is not recommended to
pregnant women and breastfeeding
mothers unless the potential benefits
clearly outweigh the risks. Terbinafine is
excreted in breastmilk

- <u>Taking other medicines</u>

The medicine is for topical application and will usually have minimal effect on other medication. However, please inform the doctor or pharmacist if taking other medicines.

How to use Nafine

- How much to use

Clean and dry the affected part. Apply cream once or twice daily. Duration of use: Fungal infection of the foot: 1 week. Limbs and groin: 1-2 weeks.

Skin: 2 weeks.

Apply sparingly and gently rub into the affected area once or twice daily until lesion has completely disappeared.

- When to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it

You should check with your doctor or pharmacist.

- If you forget to use it

If you forget to use this medicine, use it as soon as you remember. Then continue using it at your usual time.

- <u>If you use too much (overdose)</u>

If you have used too much Nafine, contact your doctor, an emergency department or a poison center immediately.

While you are using Nafine

- <u>Things you must do</u> Inform your doctor of all the medications you are taking.

- Things you must not do

Do not stop using medication although you feel better after a few days, until the prescribed course is finished.

- Things to be careful of

If you are pregnant, become pregnant, or are breastfeeding, you should not use Nafine unless advised by your doctor.

Side effects

Local irritation (redness, stinging or itching) occasionally occurs.

Storage and Disposal of Nafine

- Storage

Store in cool, dry place below 30°C. Protect from light. Keep out of reach of children.

- Disposa

Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required.
